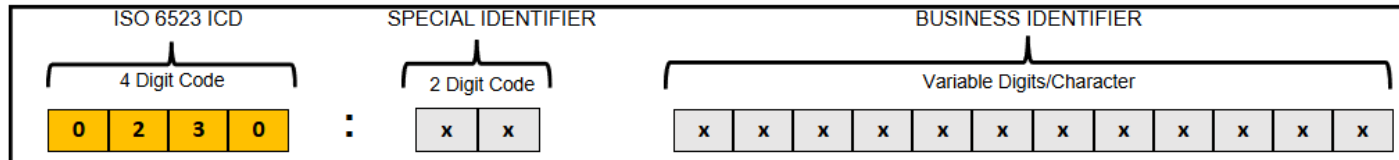


# Peppol ID

## Malaysia Peppol ID Format



### Malaysia's ISO 6523 Code

- The ISO 6523 Code for Malaysia is 0230

### Special Identifier

- 01 – SSM Number
- 02 – Sabah
- 03 – Sarawak
- 04 – Foreign Businesses
- 05 – Testing Purpose
- 06 – Others
- 07 – Statutory Body
- 08 – Local Authority

### Business Identifier

12-digit number – New SSM company registration number including Sabah & Sarawak (only for Private Limited Company/ROC).

#### Variable digits –

- i. For enterprise companies in Sabah & Sarawak, minimum 5 to a maximum of 20-digit alphanumeric.
- ii. Foreign companies will start with their country code to indicate the company's country of origin and followed by their existing registration numbers. This is applicable only to foreign companies that do not have an existing Peppol ID.
- iii. Others covers organization with other type of business registration number (e.g. ROS registration number) or special cases of business registration number.
- iv. For Statutory Bodies (SB), start with the acronym of minimum 2 to a maximum of 8 alphabetic characters, followed by two mandatory numeric digits starting with '01'. If the acronym is already in use within the Malaysia SMP, the numeric value should increase sequentially (e.g. '02', '03', until '99').
- v. For Local Authority (LA), start with the acronym of minimum 2 to a maximum of 8 alphabetic characters, followed by two mandatory numeric digits starting with '01'. If the acronym is already in use within the Malaysia SMP, the numeric value should increase sequentially (e.g. '02', '03', until '99').

Local Authority	0230:08MBSJ01
