### **Malaysia Digital Economy Corporation Detection of COVID-19 positive case**

**Cyberjaya, 11 January 2021:** Malaysia Digital Economy Corporation (MDEC) was informed today that one of our employees tested positive for COVID-19. This employee was last at the MDEC HQ at Cyberjaya last Friday, 8 January 2021 from 11am to 1pm.

The affected employee is currently exercising self-quarantine, while awaiting further instruction from the Ministry of Health. MDEC's Human Capital Division has also contacted the Sepang District Health Office to update them on the situation.

We have undertaken deep cleansing and sanitization of the areas the employee was in contact with. As a further precautionary measure, we will close MDEC HQ at Cyberjaya tomorrow 12 January 2021.

MDEC has activated its BCP and continues to operate with minimal disruptions. All employees have been on Work-from-Home arrangement with only core support staff present at the Cyberjaya premise, and on a need-to basis. The safety of our employees and companies are our priority and will keep all stakeholders updated via our social media channels.
